DOUGLAS COUNTY JAIL INMATE VISITATION SCHEDULE

A-M – SATURDAY and MONDAY N-Z – SUNDAY and TUESDAY

6:00 PM - 8:00 PM

VISITS are 15 minutes in length.

RULES

NO MORE THAN 2 VISITORS at a time per inmate unless approved, in advance, by the Sheriff and/or Jail Administrator.

All visitors <u>MUST SHOW</u> a photo ID to visit.

No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to visit without being accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

All visitors must sign in. All visitor are subject to search by on duty officers.

No cell phones are allowed in the visitation area.

No food or drinks are allowed in the visitation area

Please remember other families are visiting. If children are running or yelling, you will be asked to take them from the building.

Anyone who has been incarcerated in Douglas County Jail will not be allowed to visit until 90 DAYS after his or her release date.

All special visits <u>MUST BE</u> arranged <u>NO LESS THAN 24 HOURS</u> in advance and approved by the Sheriff and/or the Jail Administrator.

The only items for inmates allowed to be brought into the jail are money (cash or money order only) and paper back books (limit 2) No Magazines OR Newspapers Allowed.

Medicines (in original containers), and items prescribed by a doctor will be accepted only with written verification (prescription on bottle) from said doctor and must be approved by Jail Medical Staff before dispensing.
